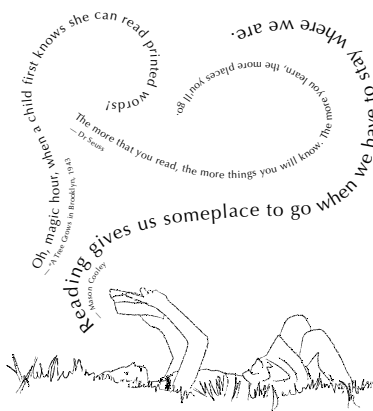
Accomplishments

In 2008, the NEF launched a new three-year campaign. Since then, significant progress has been made in all three key areas of Campaign 2008-2010. Literacy

Literacy Closets (actually rooms) hold the books that support the schools' contemporary and comprehensive approach to literacy. Through June, 2009, the NEF has donated \$100,000 to purchase a wide variety of books and materials that K-8 students are reading and talking about.

EBSCO Databases Literacy was also boosted this year through EBSCO Publishing's generous donation of several databases of primary sources. Students and teachers—as well as community members through the public library—can use these online databases for research and enrichment, exploring hundreds of publications beyond the reach of our libraries.



Virtual High School

In the Spring of 2009, students at the high school enrolled in a wide variety of courses that are difficult for a small school to offer—by taking them online. From Nuclear Physics to Music Composition, the program has something for everyone. With your help, the NEF will support this exciting program through 2011.

Technology Upgrade and Renewal

The NEF continues our quest to enable regular replacement and upgrade of technology resources, and to expand the school system's technology resources.

Visual Literacy The NEF is updating graphics software and digital and film photography equipment to support the high school's fastest growing elective, and to give NHS students practice with today's visual communication tools.

Assessment Technologies: Math and Science "Clickers" are hand-held devices that allow teachers to get immediate feedback about student progress, so lessons can be tailored to student strengths and weaknesses—and students think they are fun! Pilot programs using "clickers" that began in 2008 at several grade levels have been so successful that pilots beyond math and science are being funded in the 2009–2010 school year.

Technology for Science: Laptops Aged laptops in the high school's shared science labs were replaced with networked systems to enable the continued use of state-of-the-art software applications, and to allow more students to use the computers.

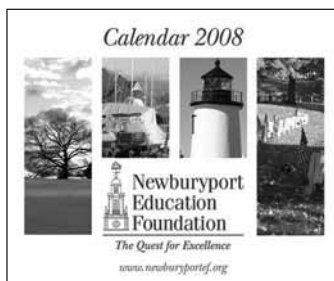

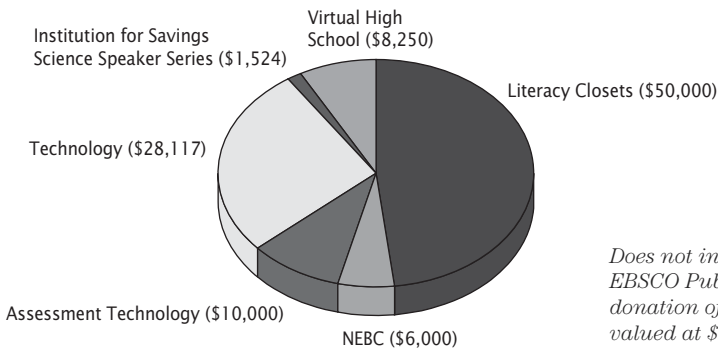

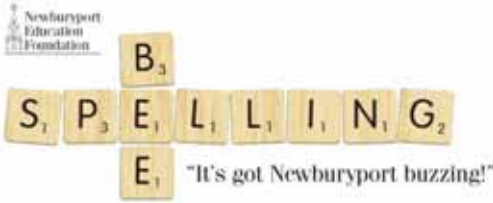
